

Service fees go into effect for the following City services:

Lien Services - Feb. 12 Business Tax - Feb. 19 Animal Control - Feb. 19 Neighborhood Services Department - Feb .26 Office of Solid Waste - Feb. 26

Division of Emergency Management - Feb. 26

A 2.35% service fee will be applied to the payment amount for all electronic transactions conducted in person, online or through the City's automated phone service. The City of Port St. Lucie does not receive any portion of the service fee.

How can I avoid a service fee?

If you wish to avoid the service fee, you can opt to pay using a personal check or money order. Alternatively, you can utilize E-Checks, which do not incur the 2.35% service fee and have a flat fee of 40 cents per transaction, regardless of the payment amount.

Why are there service fees?

This fee will apply to payments made by credit card, debit card, digital wallet, Venmo, PayPal or bank and checking accounts. The City of Port St. Lucie is not assessing the fee, nor does the City collect the fee. This is a separate service fee assessed by the processor for the convenience of making an electronic payment.
